## TCAG TAKES MEETINGS ON THE ROAD IN 2008

VISALIA — The Tulare County Association of Governments is taking off to Dinuba for its second meeting in a series of roving meetings scheduled to take place this year.

The meeting will begin at 1 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 28, at the Dinuba Memorial Building, 249 S. Alta Ave.

“By rotating our meetings throughout Tulare County, our members will get a chance to see how Measure R is being put to work countywide,” said Ted Smalley, deputy executive director of TCAG. “It will also be a great opportunity for Tulare County residents to attend a meeting they might not normally attend and provide feedback on issues that are important to them.”

Dinuba recently completed the first phase of a citywide street improvement project funded in part by Measure R funds. Completed in 2007, the first phase of the project resurfaced and rehabilitated more than 80 roads, replaced curbs and gutters and improved street drainage throughout the city.
