TCAG SEEKS NOMINATIONS FOR TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL

VISALIA — The Tulare County Association of Governments is seeking nominations to fill vacancies on the Social Service Transportation Advisory Council, including a newly created three-year youth position.

TCAG is now seeking nominations to fill three vacancies on the advisory council, which meets next at 1:30 p.m. on Sept. 25 in the Tulare County Resource Management Agency Planning Commission Room located at 5961 S. Mooney Boulevard. The council meets quarterly to discuss local and regional social services transit issues. Also, each spring, SSTAC reviews unmet transit needs voiced by the public through the annual Unmet Transit Needs Hearing process, then recommendations to TCAG.

TCAG is seeking nominations to fill the following vacancies on SSTAC:

- A representative of potential transit users who is 60 years old or older.
- A representative of local social service providers for seniors.
- A representative of potential transit users from local youth between the ages of 18-25.
